

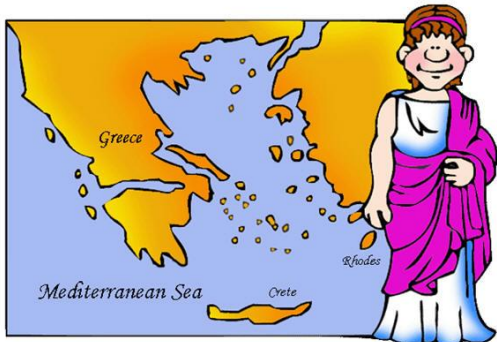
Jaguars Class Update

In our topic on **Ancient Greece**, we will delve into the geographical and chronological contexts of key events from that period. We will explore the concepts of 'trade,' 'civilization,' and 'empire' while investigating aspects of daily life and the development of early democracy. Using ancient Greek pottery as a primary source, we will compare ancient and modern Olympic games; explore aspects of Greek mythology and chart the narrative of the Trojan War from historical evidence.

English: To begin, we will be writing a couple of pieces to complete our SATs assessments. This will be followed by writing about our time at LEPS for our record of achievement.

Maths: We shall be generally revising all the areas we have covered in the form of investigations, while focusing on the final areas of our Year 6 curriculum: Statistics.

PE: Wednesday am – Tennis

For tennis, children arrive in PE kit and bring in school clothes to change into.

Homework:

This will not be as regular as previous terms; however, continuing reading will help their transition to Year 7 and we need to focus on the play.
