Our learning in June to July 2022:

In our 'Raging Rivers' topic, we will name and locate the major rivers of the UK and the world. As well as looking at the features of rivers, we shall explore the natural and human ways that rivers change over time and the journey they take

Our Science topic will be, '**Evolution**'. We will recognise how living things produce offspring who inherit certain characteristics; investigate the terms 'variation' and 'adaption'; explore how Charles Darwin and Alfred Wallace separately developed their theories. Looking at how these theories have been developed through evidence, we will look at the course of human evolution.



English: In connection with our Science work, we shall be writing 'Just so' stories about animal origins, this is based on Rudyard Kipling's classic children's book. This will be followed by writing about our time at LEPS for our record of achievement.

Maths: We shall be generally recapping all the areas we have covered, while focusing on the final areas of our Year 6 curriculum:

- Algebra part 2
- Statistics
- Investigations.

PE: Thursdays – children **bring in** to school their PE kit (plain, white top; plain, dark shorts/trousers; dark jumper/hoodie; trainers NOT pumps; and socks) and change before the lesson starts. It is important children have the **correct uniform for PE**, as they would for a school day.

Ultimate Frisbee! On Tuesday mornings, we have the exciting opportunity to take part in Frisbee lessons. On these days, children need to **arrive in their PE kit**, bringing their school uniform to change into.

This term we shall be very busy rehearsing and learning the songs for our end of year play: 'Reach for the Sky'. Children will have scripts and sets of words: these will also be available on our class page, along with recording of the music.
