Although this Summer term is a short term (5 weeks), there will be a lot taking place!

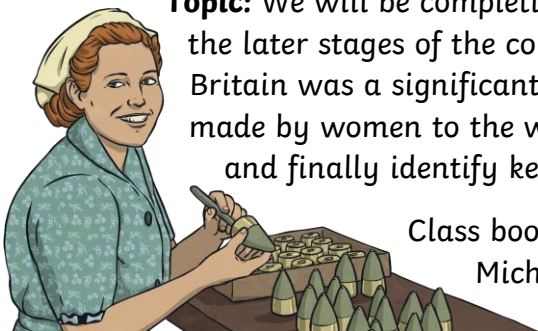
SATs week.

Children have been working extremely hard practising for this important week. The dates are as follows:

- Monday 9th May – SPAG papers 1 & 2
- Tuesday 10th May – Reading Comprehension (1 hour)
- Wednesday 11th May – Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic) & Maths 2 (Reasoning)
- Thursday 12th May – Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning)

It would be helpful if you could encourage your child to have as much sleep as possible during the weekend before, to give them a good chance at doing their best with refreshed minds.

Topic: We will be completing our World War II theme. Focusing on the later stages of the conflict, we will consider why the Battle of Britain was a significant turning point, look at the contribution made by women to the war effort, explore what the Holocaust was and finally identify key events which brought an end to the war.

Design and Technology: In the week following SATs, we will be designing and creating cushions. During the project, children will decide upon a design fit for a defined purpose and produce their own unique individual cushion. We will use the opportunity to focus on writing instructions for an assessed piece of work.

English: To begin the term, we will be focusing on sharpening our comprehension techniques; this will be followed by writing a suspenseful piece of fiction focusing on description and dialogue.

Maths: This half term our Maths will include:

- Algebra
- Introducing Ratio
- Practising reasoning questions.

Useful information:

- **PE:** Thursdays – children **bring in** to school their PE kit (plain, white top; plain, dark shorts/trousers; dark jumper/hoodie; trainers NOT pumps; and socks) and change before the lesson starts. It is important children have the **correct uniform for PE**, as they would for a school day.
