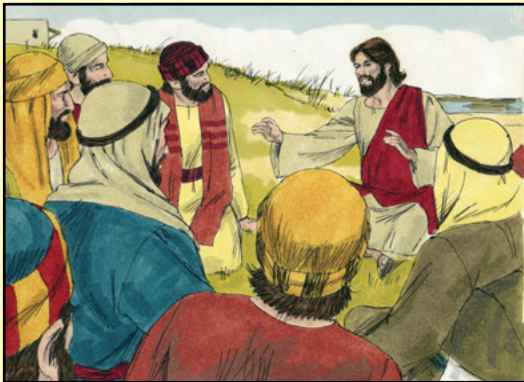
A parable Luke 12: 16-21

Then Jesus told them this parable:
