

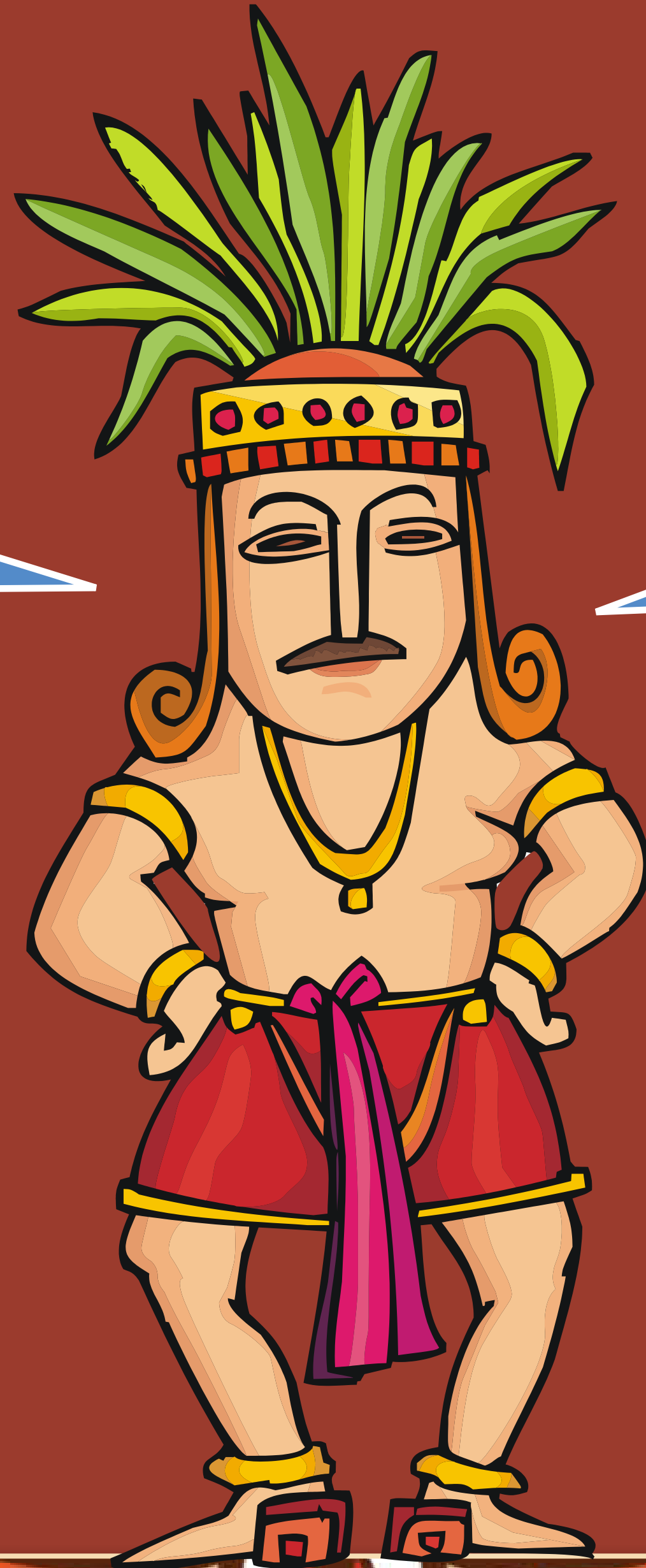

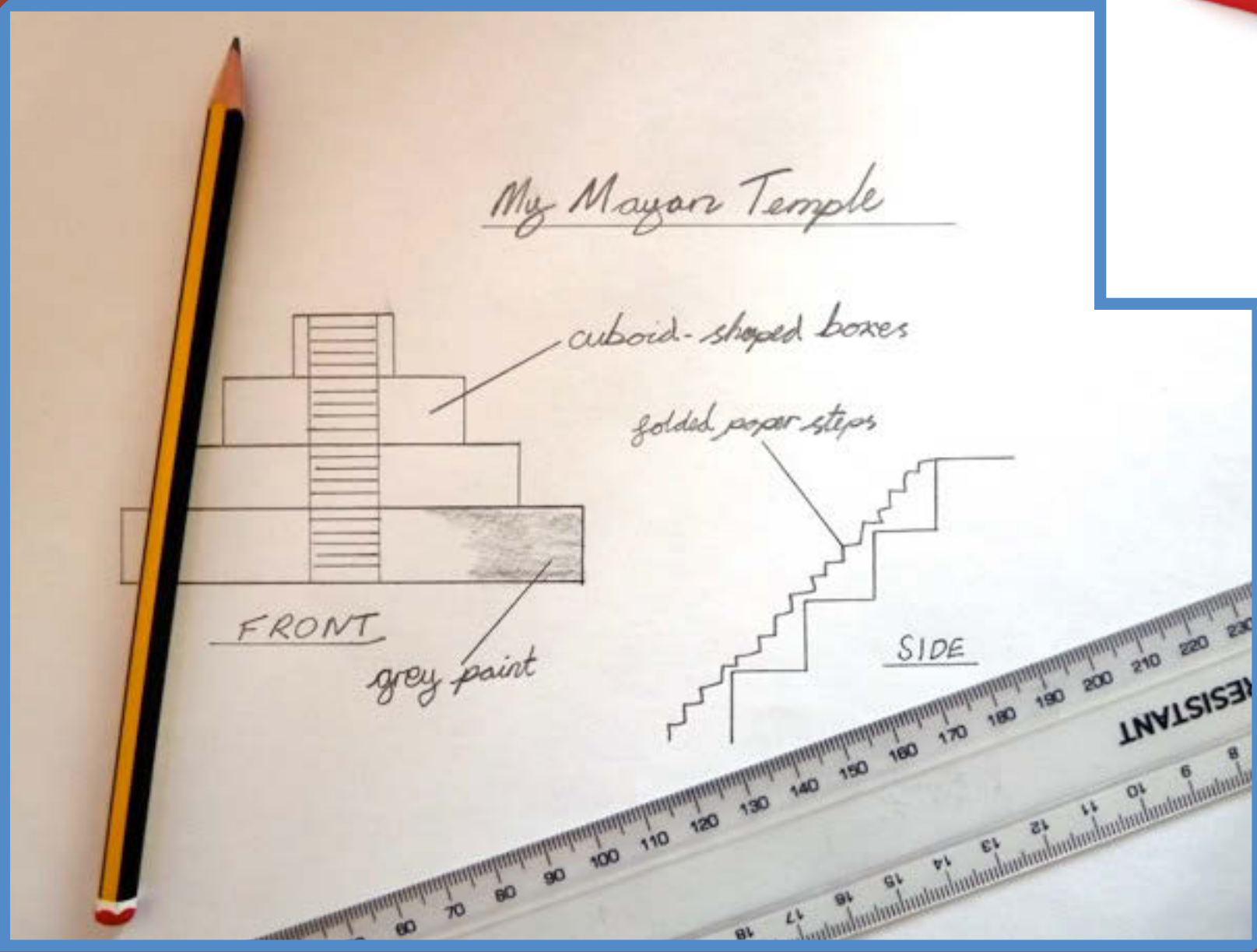
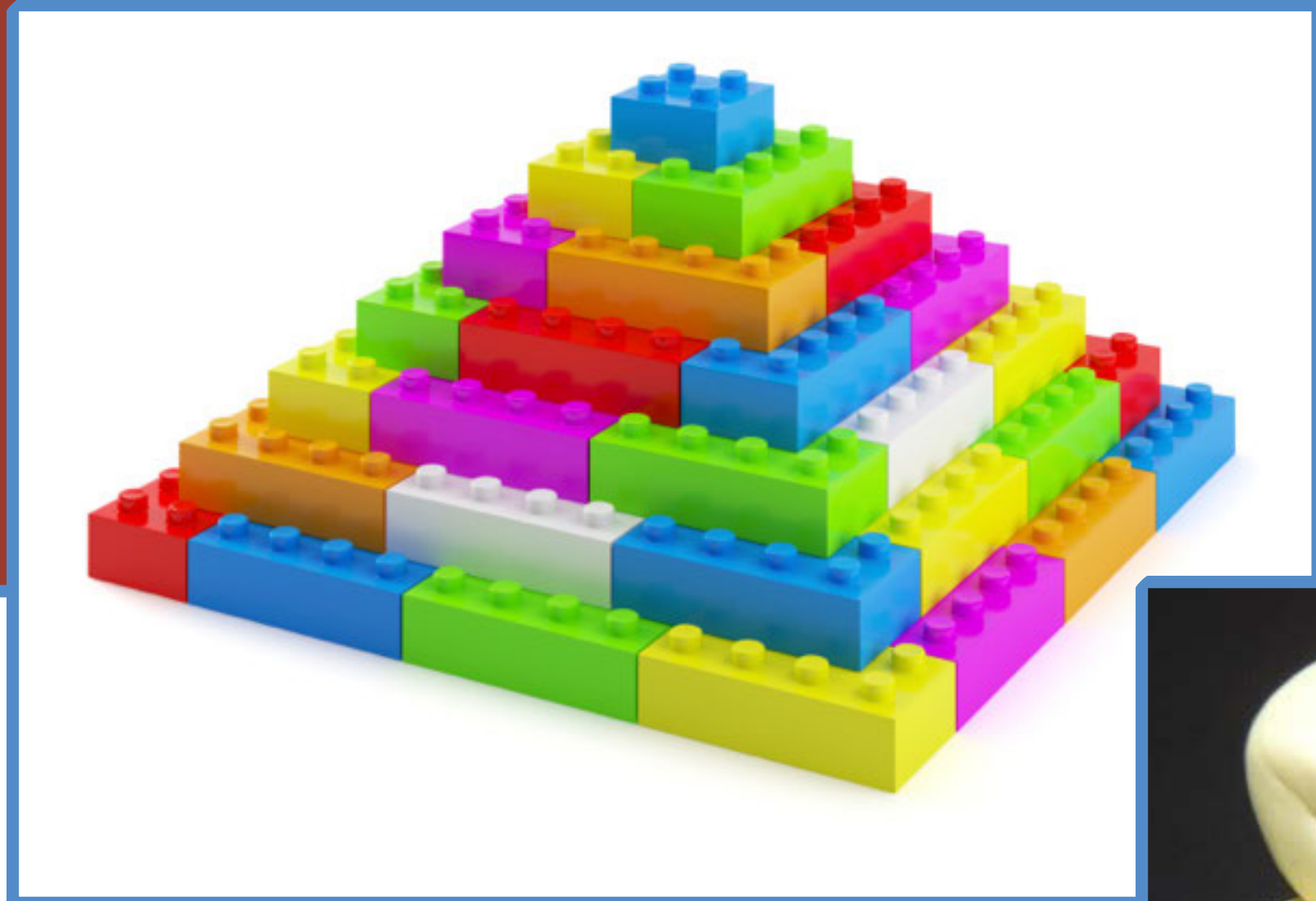


How could you make sure that the structure would be sturdy?

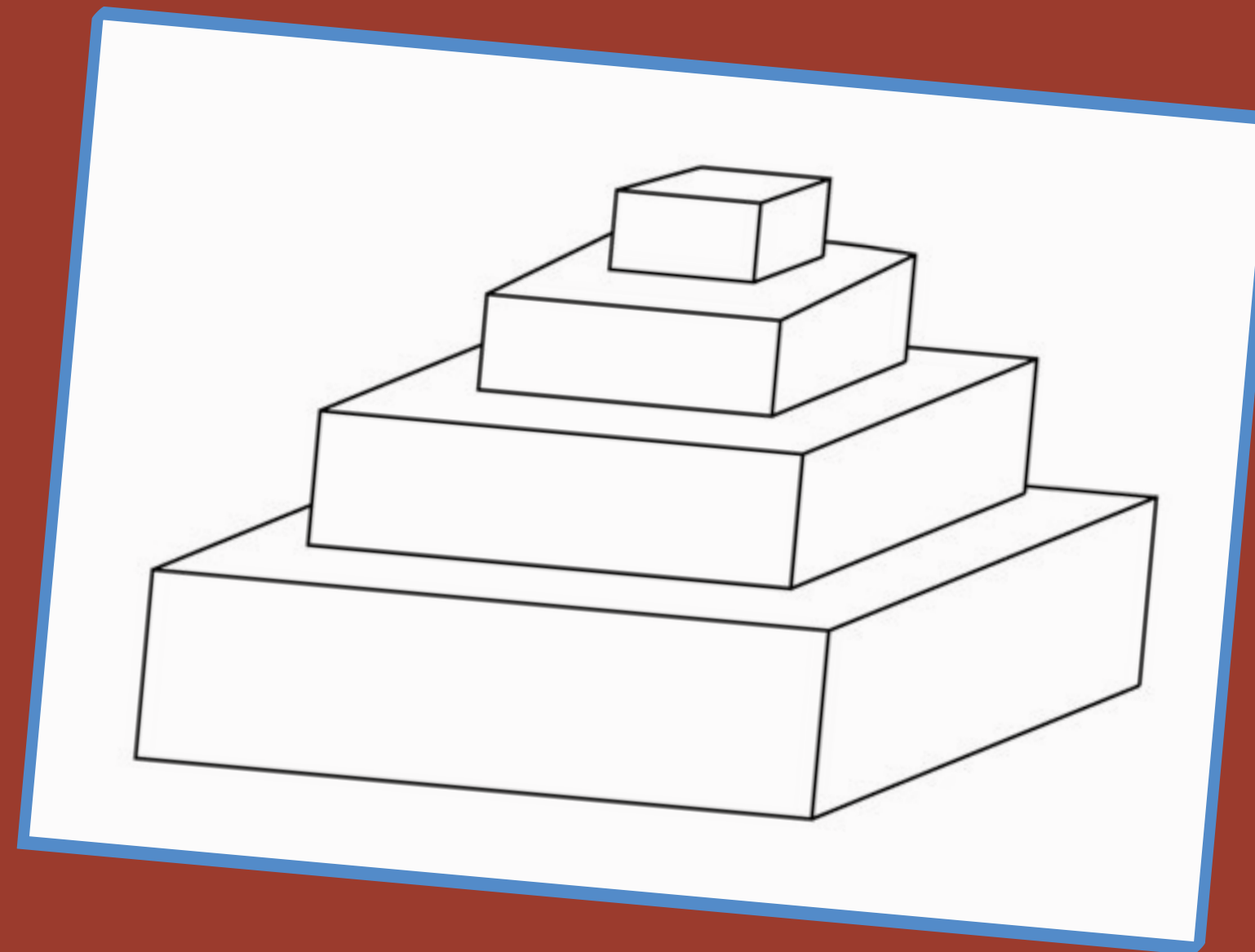
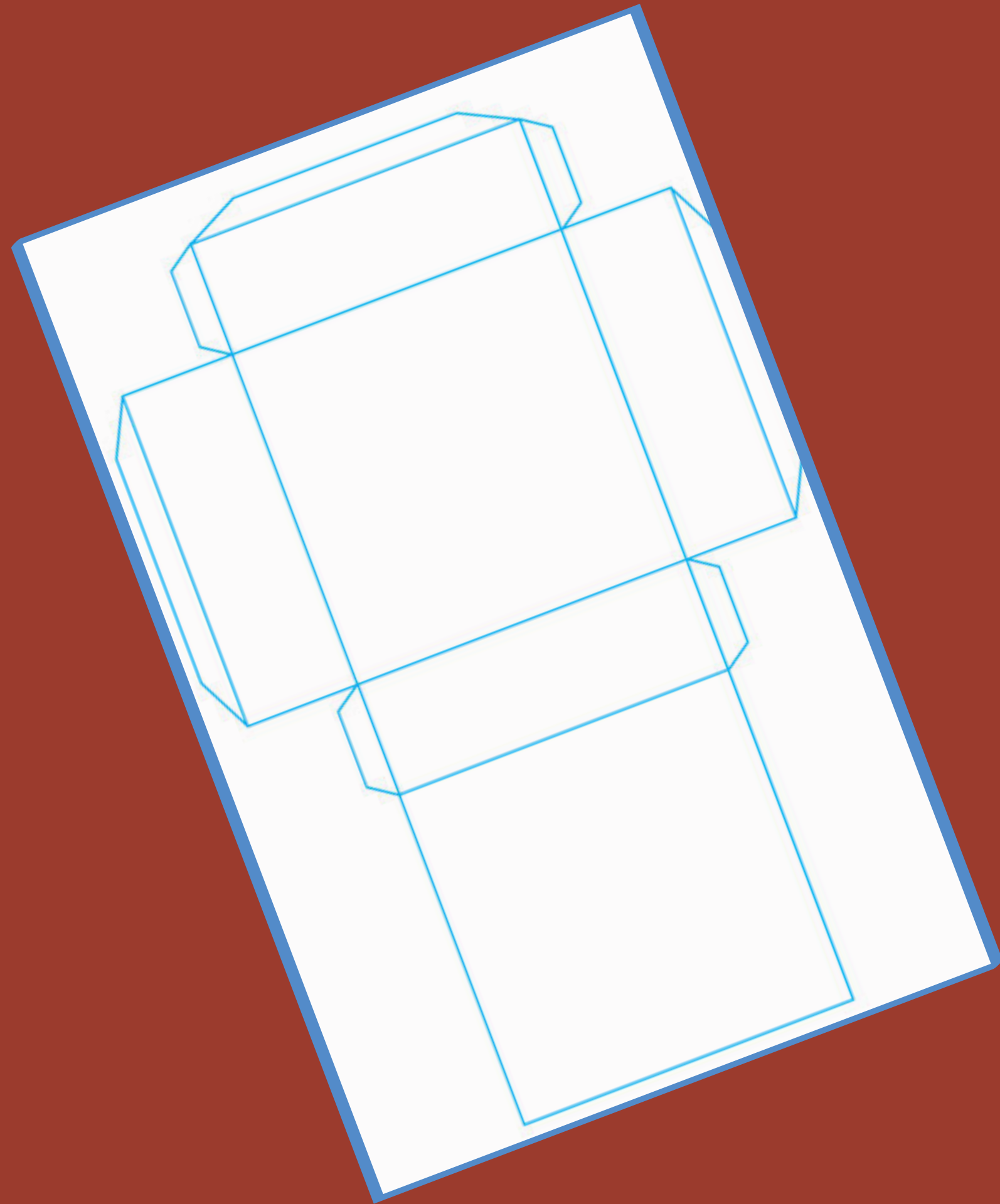
You could draw, use building bricks or playdough to design your temple...

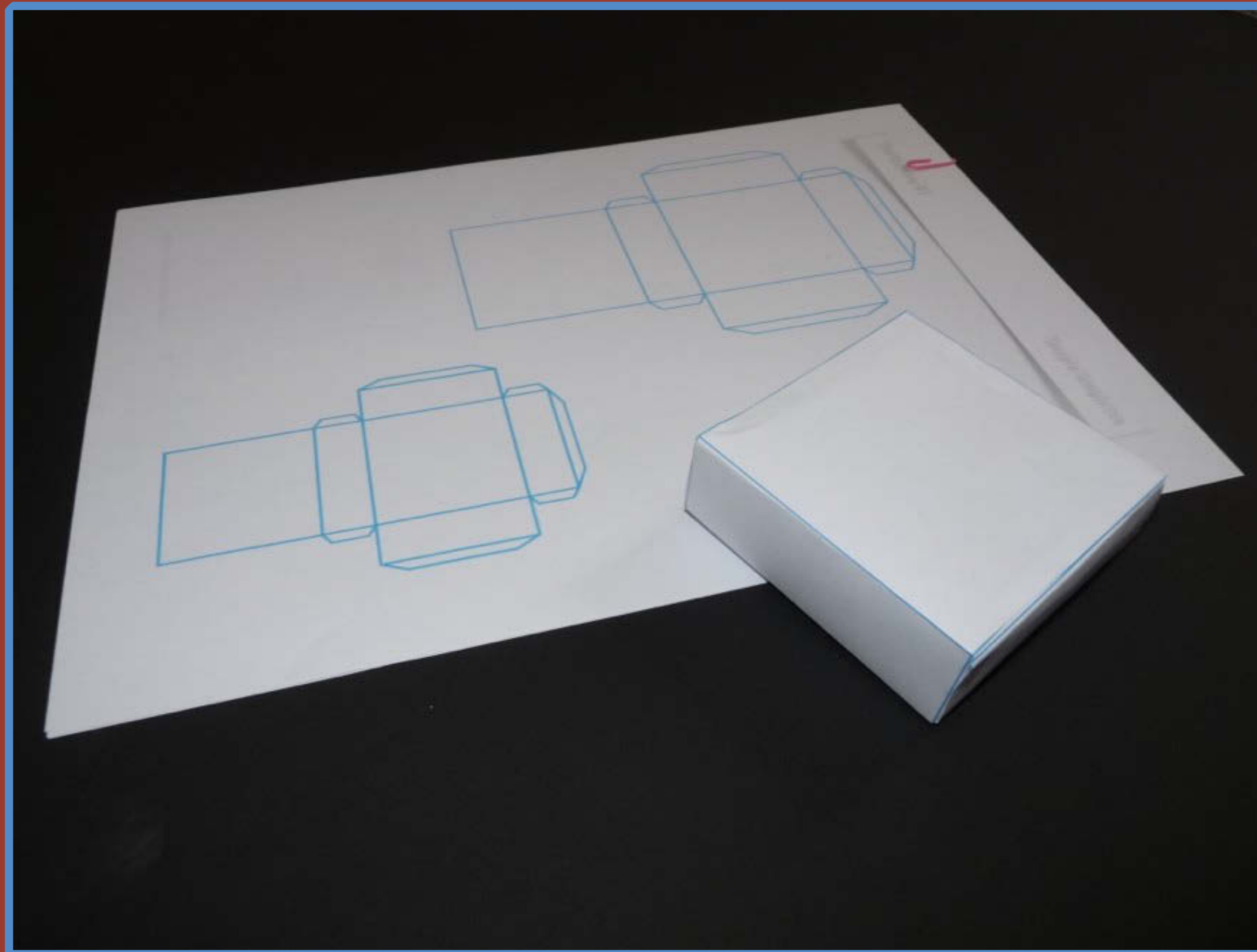
You could use cardboard boxes, paper or foam sheets to make your design...

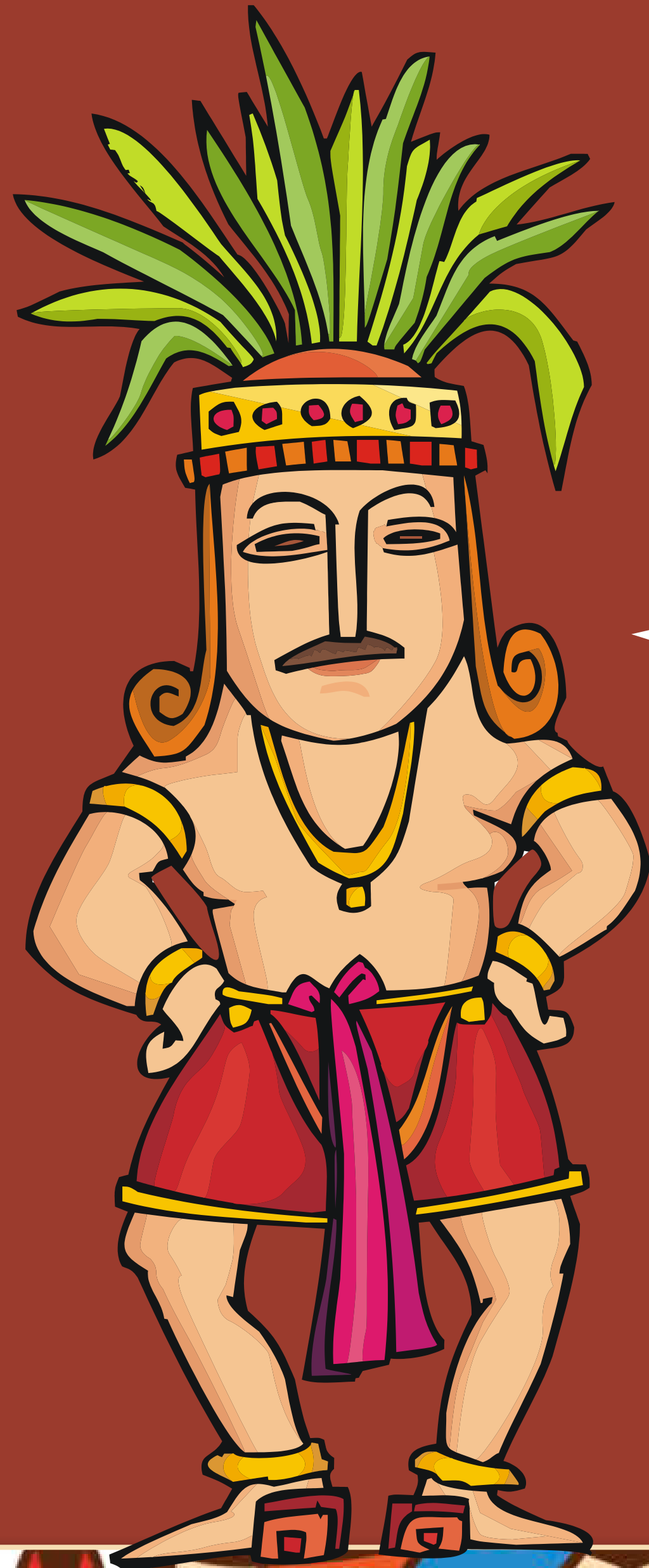
