## History

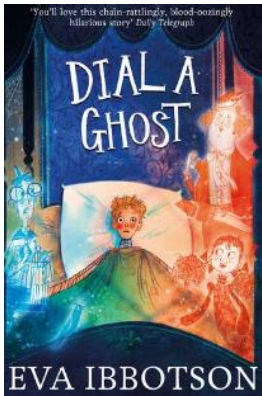
We will be learning about Inventors and Scientists. This will involve learning about Tim Burners-Lee and his invention of the World Wide Web; W K Wilkinson and his invention of reinforced concrete; Alexander Graham Bell and his invention of the telephone and more!

## English

## Maths

This half term, we will be learning about Shape, Position and Direction and Decimals. This learning will be reflected in our weekly homework to help to consolidate our learning in school.

## Science

In Science, we will be learning about Earth and Space. This will include a trip to the National Space Centre on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2023. We will be learning about lots of different aspects of Earth and Space including; night and day, movement of the moon, the planets, heliocentric and geocentric solar systems and more!

## Other Subjects

- **Forest Schools** – The groups will swap this half term. Children who are in forest school will need to bring a change of clothes and suitable outdoor shoes.
- **Computing** – In Computing, we will be learning about how to draw using the computing alongside our Art topic.
