Welcome back to the next half term of the year!

History

In our history topic this half term, we will be learning about the Ancient Mayan Civilisation. This will involve learning about their way of life, jobs, food, number systems, masks, Mayan gods, where they lived and so much more!



We will also be going on a trip to **Cadbury World** on 14th December 2022. We will go on a tour of Cadbury World, which features the Maya's involvement in the early history of cocoa in c.AD 900.

Art

In Art we will design and make our own Mayan masks. This will involve using a range of materials to make and cover the masks. Keep an eye on our class page for photos of the process!

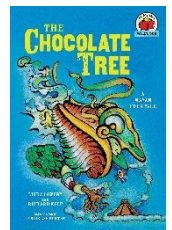


D.T.

In DT we will be making cushions! This will involve designing the cushions and making them throughout a week project. The children will make a cushion of their choice and be able to keep it.

English

Across the half term, we will be reading a range of texts. Our class readers will be finishing reading The Explorer and then, we will be reading **The Chocolate Tree** - linking to our Topic the Mayans. Please feel free to get a copy of the book to read along with the book in class.



The children will complete a weekly comprehension to work on our written comprehension skills and ability to answer questions about a text. We will also continue to have Whole Class Reading sessions on a Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday morning. This involves using the VIPERS to answer questions about a text we are reading.



In writing, we will be writing a narrative, focusing on a portal story; instructions on how to make a cushion; reviewing Christmas songs and finally, understanding the figurative language in Christmas songs.

Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing to build our skills in Multiplication and Division and begin to look at Fractions.

In Fractions we will be covering a range of areas, such as: equivalent fractions, converting fractions, comparing fractions, adding, and subtracting fractions and consolidating all of our learning so far this year.

Science

We will be continuing our topic 'Properties and Changes of Materials'. This half term we will be covering more areas of knowledge and making predictions about materials and their properties, then checking our predictions through investigations.

Other Subjects

- **Forest Schools** - The groups will swap this half term. Children who are in forest school will need to bring a change of clothes and suitable outdoor shoes.
- **Computing** - In Computing the children will learn about film making, then they will have a go at filming their own Christmas advert.
- In **R.E.**, the children will be continuing to learn about 'Why do some people believe God exists?'
- **P.S.H.E**, this half term, will focus on the **TEAM**
- Mrs. Schumann will continue to teach **French** on a **Thursday** afternoon.
- Mr. Singh will be teaching **P.E.** this half term, on a **Thursday**. This will require the children to bring their P.E kits to get changed into.



Weekly Routines

- **P.E.** - We will be doing Fitness and Karate this half term. P.E. will be on a **Thursday Morning**.
- **Swimming** - We will continue to swim on a Monday afternoon. Please be aware, we do sometimes get stuck in the traffic around John Flamsted school, so could be slightly later than 3:30.
