Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to school! I hope you have all enjoyed a restful break. I can hardly believe we are half way through the school year already. The children continue to make great progress and amaze us everyday.

This half term the adults working in Star Class will be Mrs Simmons, Miss Key, Mrs Askew, and Mrs Roberts.

Our topics this half term will include learning about Spring, Easter, Eid, Growing, Oral Health, Animals and their habitats. As always we will also be following the children's interests. A detailed outline of what we will be covering can be found on the class page.

In terms of reading, children will continue to bring home reading books. We kindly ask that you leave occasional comments on Tapestry to share how your child is engaging with their books. It's crucial that you read with your child for about 10 minutes each day to foster their love for reading.

The Book Changing Days are as follows:

- Monday: Red and Green teams.
- Tuesday: Yellow and Blue teams.

For phonics, we will be continuing to learn Level 3 and consolidating our understanding this half term.

PE will take place on Thursday mornings, so please ensure your child has a named PE kit in school to facilitate changing.

Dates for this Half Term:

Tuesday 4th March- Pancake Day- We will be having pancake races, eating pancakes and counting pancakes.

Thursday 6th March- World Book Day- Children can come to school in fancy dress or their own clothes if they would prefer. We will be watching Treasure Island in the afternoon.

Friday 14th March- School is called for an INSET day.

Week Commencing 17th March is STEM week so we will be doing lots of finding out that week.

Tuesday 25th and Wednesday 26th March- Parents Evening.

Other Information:

In Little Eaton School, we celebrate each child's birthday by allowing them to wear their own clothes for the day. There is no pressure for them to wear anything other than their uniform if they would prefer. Should their birthday fall during a holiday or on the weekend, they may wear their own clothes on the next school day.

As part of your child's journey through Reception, we encourage teamwork and collaboration. Please send in observations of your child's activities, as it's wonderful to see what they get up to, and it can greatly assist in informing their profile on Tapestry.

A gentle reminder: please ensure that drinks bottles do not go into book bags, as they tend to leak. Additionally, it is important for your child to have a coat at school every day, as we will be playing outdoors whatever the weather brings.
