
Raging Rivers

In our 'Raging Rivers' topic, we will name and locate the major rivers of the UK and the world. As well as looking at the features of rivers, we shall explore the natural and human ways that rivers change over time and the journey they take

Our Science topic '**Evolution**' will continue this term, looking at factors which affect changes, an understanding of human evolution and how human behaviour can affect changes in a species over time



English: In connection with our Science work, we shall be writing a 'Just so' story about animal origins, based on Rudyard Kipling's classic children's book and a non-chronological report on the animal we chose. This will be followed by writing about our time at LEPS for our record of achievement.

Maths: We shall be generally revising all the areas we have covered in the form of investigations, while focusing on the final areas of our Year 6 curriculum: Statistics.

PE: Wednesday am – Tennis and Thursdays normal PE lesson

For tennis, children **arrive** in PE kit and **bring in** school clothes to change into.

Otherwise, children **bring in** to school their PE kit and change before the lesson starts.
