Our learning in June to July 2025:

In our 'Raging Rivers' topic, we will name and locate the major rivers of the UK and the world. As well as looking at the features of rivers, we shall explore the natural and human ways that rivers change over time and the journey they take.

English: To begin, we will be writing a couple of pieces to complete our SATs assessments. This will be followed by writing about our time at LEPS for our record of achievement.

Maths: We shall be generally revising all the areas we have covered in the form of investigations, while focusing on the final areas of our Year 6 curriculum: Statistics.

PE: Wednesday am – Tennis. Children arrive in PE kit and bring in school clothes to change into.

Homework:

This will not be as regular as previous terms; however, continuing reading will help their transition to Year 7 and we need to focus on the play.

- Reading – DAILY (20 minutes a day at home). Each child is allowed to read independently at home, however it is vital that occasionally parents listen to their child read and discuss their reading with them. **Please add a signature when you have heard your child read.**
- Reading Comprehension - handed out Monday: return complete the following Monday.
- Maths – handed out on Friday to be completed and handed in the following Wednesday.
